INTRODUCTORY

Panchkula District is situated on the Shivalik Foot Hills and is a gateway to Sub Himalaya plains. It has two sub Divisions namely Panchkula and Kalka and two Tehsils: namely Panchkula and Kalka. In Panchkula Tehsil, there are 3 Sub Tehsils namely Barwala, Raipur Rani and Morni. The basic information about the District is as under: -

A number of rivers and seasonal rivulets that flows through this District basically drain out almost all the rain waters from the hills to the Great Plains. Main rivers like Ghagger. Tangri, Kaushalya and Omla flow through this district. In this district there is no major problem of floods. However, there is a problem of soil erosion. Being sub mountainous area the rivers wash away land. The component of nature is beyond our control. However, the human component to fight the flood disaster, if it takes place, is within our control. Efforts shall be made to pool the resources at our disposal from all corners and to make use of our managerial power. The cumulative wisdom and experience of Revenue. Drainage (Water Services Division) Food and Supplies, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Health, P.W.D., Public Health, Forests etc. has been pooled up to bring out the Brochures named as Flood Control Order, 2011. The cause leading to floods in this district are enumerated below: -

**FLOOD PREPAREDNESS/ FLOOD PROTECTION WORK OF
DISTT. PANCHKULA.**

**Minutes of inspection of DC Panchkula for the flood protection works
of Distt. Panchkula for the year 2011-12 held on 22/04/2011.**

The terrain of Panchkula Distt. is sub mountainous of natural slope is steep. The rivers/ rivulets originating from the hills pass through the district. As the slopes are very steep flood water generally does not accumulate and passes downstream of the district.

It is further informed by Executive Engineer, Irrigation Department during the meeting that Singh Nallah Choe passes through the Panchkula Town. Due to encroachment on the Singh Nallah Choe in the Punjab territory, the flood water of Singh Nallah Choe overflows the Panchkula Town. To solve this problem of flooding in Panchkula Town a diversion drain with a capacity of 2500 Cs to be constructed, so that whole of the flood water entering the Singh Nallah Choe upstream of the Panchkula Town be diverted into river Ghaggar through the Military area. The construction of the diversion of Singh Nallah Choe has been started.

A list of flood protection works which has been approved in 42nd meeting of Haryana State Flood Control Board has already been given to D.C. Panchkula. Inspection of flood works was carried out by District Administration alongwith D.C. Panchkula on 22/04/2011. After inspection D.C. Panchkula desired that flood works be completed before the onset of the monsoons.

Administrative set-up

Administrative set up to combat Floods in Panchkula District is as under Panchkula District has four Development Blocks. There will be six base control rooms at 'A' level (Block level). They will disseminate the information to 'B' level Control rooms, which are at tehsil offices. The 'C' level Control rooms will be Sub Master Control rooms for each Sub Division which have the power to decided on the spot about the course of action to be taken and then in all cases to inform the master Control room at 'D' level which is situated at Deputy Commissioner's office, Panchkula (Tehsil Building). Besides the Revenue Development Branch Control Room, the drainage deptt. will have its communication net work at Key points. For Tangri River the point will be Barwala Bataur Bridge. Wolkie-Talkie sets are set to be provided by the drainage deptt where necessity arises.

Wireless network of Forest Department will also be used for passing information regarding rainfall in the Morni Hills. Divisional Forest Officer, Morni at Pinjore will depute the forest officials of Morni Block who are having wireless sets for giving information in respect of their area regarding (a) the time of starting, of rain if it continues for more than 30 minutes (b) its intensity and (c) land sliding causing harm to the public.

The above mentioned information shall be passed on by Morni Control Room of Forest Department to the Control Room of 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' levels immediately.

The Executive Engineer Ghaggar Dam Division, Panchkula will make use of the irrigation Telegraph network on the receipt of high flood warning when the discharge exceeds 30,000 cusics. The 'D' level Control Room will be informed which in turn will arrange for Public help for the effected areas. The onus of taking preventive measure will be on 'B' level Control Room Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), where the respective Sub Divisional Officer (Civil) will take all necessary action to meet the threat. The Block Development & Panchayat Officer will ensure vide publicity of high floods in affected

area. Block Development & Panchayat Officer will also make arrangements to stag sand bags insufficient numbers in advance so that the same could be used at the time of necessity.

He will be assisted by the Assistant Superintendent Revenue, Deputy Commissioner Office and Flood Relief Assistant. At the Sub Divisional level Control Room the respective Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), will be the over all in charge of the control room. Similarly, at the Tehsil level the respective Tehsildar and at the Block level the respective BD&PO will be incharge at his Head Quarter.

The Drainage Department will be responsible to report the discharge of Tangri from Barwala Bataur Bridge. The Executive Engineer, Ghaggar Dam Division, Panchkula will make use of Tele-graph system immediately on receipt of high flood warning exceeding 30,000 cusecs. The Deputy Commissioner should be informed by the quick means even though he may not be at the head quarter, like wise the Superintendent of Police will be informed who will arrange for necessary Police help where necessary. The Tehsildar BD&PO/SHO concerned will make arrangements of publicity in the event of high floods. All these offices at field level will have complete coordination with each other. The Superintendent of Police, Panchkula will arrange to install wireless sets at prominent places like Barwala. Morni where Police Stations are not available.

Duty Chart District Panchkula:-

The Officer- In charge at the district level will be in constant touch with State level Control Room as well as well the Control Room of police and Irrigation Deptt. The message will immediate be passed on to the Sub Divisional Officer (c)/ Tehsildar who will take prompt and necessary action. It is further clarified that all the Flood Control Room will function round the clock form Ist July to 30 Spt. 2011. Duty Roaster register shall be maintained by officer-in-charge of each Control Room.

Duty of Officer:-

- i) To make standing arrangement for providing receipt of flood warning.
- ii) To collect and tabulate information regarding flood situation in the respective area.
- iii) To keep the Deputy Commissioner informed about the upto date position regarding floods.
- iv) To maintain statistics regarding floods affected areas and nature of damage, if any.
- v) To convey information regarding floods to the higher authorities & state Control room at Chandigarh.
- vi) To maintain maps of Tehsil/Sub Tehsil.
- vii) To coordinate and organize flood relief measures and guide those who seek assistance.
- viii) To make arrangements for prompt dispatch of information, regarding floods to relief /evacuation centers.

District Tehsil Control Room shall promptly supply the information of floods to the Distt. Revenue Officer, Panchkula and shall send the information, if necessary to the Commissioner, Ambala Division, A/Cantt. And the Financial Commissioner, (Revenue) and eth State Control Room at Chandigarh.

Flood Warning System:-

Though no exact warning can be given regarding floods due to heavy rains, yet respective S.D.Os (C) Tehsildars and other, Revenue and Development Officials in all the Sub Divisions will have to remain alert as soon as the heavy rains set in. They would keep the Dy. Commissioner informed about the developing situation. Particular attention will be paid to the situation in the areas which are generally affected by heavy rains. The irrigation Deptt shall also be responsible for recording the discharge of Ghaggar River. The Irrigation Deptt. Shall also be responsible for recoding the discharge of Ghaggar River. The Executive Engineer WS Division, Panchkula will make use of Irrigation telegraph system immediately on receipt of high flood warning exceeding 50000 Cs. The Deputy Commissioner would be informed by quickest means even through he may be in a Camp of outside the headquarter. Likewise the Supdt. Of police, will arrange for necessary Police help for affected people.

Control Room Headquarter and other Measure established by Civil Administration during Monsoon season, their charter of duties:-

In the rainy season all the SDMs, Tehsildars, BD&Pos and employees of their respective departments will remain alert and they will maintain the headquarters. They will send daily report about the rainfall and situation. The Drainage Deptt. will inform to the District Administration about the quantity of water in cusics in the rivers and issue warning about the level of the river, if crossing the danger mark. The Telegraphic System of irrigations Deptt. will be used by whole transmitting information form one reach to another reach and ultimately to the Central Control Room of Distt. Revenue Officer. Flood Control Rooms will be established at the following places at the district:-

The employees will be deputed in all the control rooms round the clock. The list of the control rooms and their telephone numbers will be published in the news papers, so that any person can contact these control rooms, for information and help. Any serious incident and any vital information received at the control rooms will immediately be sent to the Tehsil office Panchkula control room and to the Deputy Commissioner for further necessary action.

Frequency/ mechanism for interaction with civil flood control organization/ concerned person during monsoon season:-

As already explained in para 6 any serious complaint of flood or any vital information regarding flood received in the control rooms will be communicated immediately to the Central Control Room and subsequently to the Deputy Commissioner. The control rooms will send the report every day morning of any serious flood situation in the Central Control Room.

District Panchkula over-all responsibility of the following Officers for their respective areas will be as under: -

1. **Tehsildar, Panchkula and Naib Tehsildar, Panchkula**
All villages falling in the jurisdiction of Revenue Officers.
2. **Sub Tehsil, Barwala**
Block Development Officer, Barwala and Naib Tehsildar, Barwala. All Villages of Barwala sub Tehsil.
3. **Sub Tehsil, Raipur Rani**
Block Development Officer, Raipur Rani and Naib Tehsildar, Raipur Rani. All Villages of Raipur Rani Sub Tehsil.
4. **Sub Tehsil, Morni**
Block Development Officer, Morni at Naib Tehsildar, Morni. All Villages of Sub Tehsil, Morni.
5. **Kalka Tehsil**
Tehsildar, Kalka / Naib Tehsildar, Kalka / BD&PO, Pinjore. All Villages of Kalka Tehsil.

Civil Surgeon, Panchkula

- A Flood Control Room has been established in Civil Surgeon Office, Panchkula and Deputy Civil Surgeon (Health), Panchkula has been nominated as Nodal Officer for Flood Control Programme.
- Sufficient medicines including Chlorine Tablets, Bleaching powder and Anti Snake Venom have been arranged for the Flood Control Programme.
- Teams of Paramedical Staff have been constituted for Flood prone area and slum area such as Rajiv Colony, Indira Colony, Buddan Pur and Azad Colony. These teams will visit house to house for survey and treatment of various diseases such as Diarrhea, Vomiting, Fever etc. They will also make blood slides of the fever cases.
- To Control flies and mosquitoes various teams have been constituted for fogging in the flood prone area and slum area.
- To control Water Borne Diseases epidemic Act 1897 will be enforced and hand bills will be distributed to educate public regarding water borne diseases such as Diarrhea, Cholera, Jaundice etc.
- Special instructions have been given to the Incharge of all health institutions.
- Flood Controls have been established in all health institutions. Detail list is enclosed herewith.

Before the start of rainy season Civil Surgeon, Panchkula shall arrange that bleaching of wells and distributions of drugs, spray of DDT/Anti Larva and fogging other suitable and recommended insecticide haven been arranged. The Civil Surgeon, Panchkula to deploy suitable no. of medical and para medical staff in case of need. Medical Officer of Civil Hospital at the Sub Divisional, Tehsil Head Quarter would be readily availably for contact before special Medical Relief Teams are sent from Distt. HQ.
